Whether you are a seasoned competition rider or a beginner, we have classes for you at our Schooling show. Get ready for your next big show, give your horse or yourself more experience, or try something new in our low key, supportive schooling show atmosphere. Classes available from beginner ground poles to 2.3" eventing.

Registration forms and entry fees must be received by Thursday, September 6th. You can mail (check, paypal or credit card) or email your registration form (paypal or credit card). Credit cards and paypal incur a \$2 processing fee. No entries without fees can be accepted.

General Show information

- Limited stalling available, get your registration in early. Stalls are \$20 per night. 2 paddocks available suitable for multiple horses that get along and are usually pastured together, \$50 each, contact us.
- Must bring your own buckets, hay, feed. 1 bag of shavings included. Must clean your own stall.
- Trailer jump out available for free. We can help you park and turn your trailer if needed.
- Stalls can be occupied at 5pm on Friday for clinic participants, or Saturday 5pm for competitors
- Limited Saturday evening x-country schooling may be available for \$20/horse/rider at 6pm (weather depending)
- In an effort to keep costs low we ask riders (for riders under 12 a parent or caregiver) to volunteer 1 -2 hrs on day of show and their volunteer fee will be refunded. Volunteer assignments with specific times will be send out with the riding schedule. If you find yourself unable to volunteer or do not show up for your shift, the \$10 volunteer fee will be kept to be paid to hired help.
- A \$10 office fee applies for each show
- Class fees: Dressage \$10 per test, jumping/hunters/equitation and rail classes \$5, 3 phase Eventing (you do not have to sign up for 3 classes separately in this case, unless you want extra rides \$80, extra x-country rounds if signed up for eventing \$20
- EVENTING SPECIAL PACKAGE: \$120 for eventing in division of choice, stall, all fees and xcounrty schooling time, that's a \$20 saving.
- Concessions will be available
- Helmets and Boots are required when mounted, no exceptions.
- Office is open Sunday 9am to 9.30am and 12pm to 12.30pm

- All competitors must have signed liability waiver included in registration.
- No dogs or smoking allowed on premises.
- Over fence classes are held in a 150x 75 ft indoor arena with sand footing and 20ft ceiling. On the flat weather permitting is in a 90x150 outdoor arena with sand footing
- Lesson horses for established RREC students are available for \$25 horse fee per day, ask your instructor. Lesson students must have had at least 2 lessons in the month before the show to be eligible to show a school horse.
- Western tack allowed over fence classes up to 12", all games, western dressage and trail versatility. No western tack for x-country other than trail versatility
- A schedule with entries will be emailed to all riders on Friday before the show, which includes your volunteer assignment if you chose to volunteer.
- Jump heights: heights stated are upper limits. Cross rails will be no more than 12" on the outside.
- Oxers will be no wider than 1.2x the height limit of the class. No oxers in 18" or under classes.
- X-country maybe cancelled or postponed due to inclement weather. Eventing rain out date Sept 15th

Ribbons and Awards

Ribbons to at least third place for each class.

High Point Dressage Champion: Highest score from all under saddle dressage tests receives championship ribbon and \$10 gift certificate

High Point Jumping: Best placings from up to 6 H/J classes on Sunday (points awarded depending on people in class and placing, e.g. first in a class of 6 riders get 6 pts, second gets 5, etc). Championship ribbon and \$10 gift certificate

Eventing Champion: Lowest total penalty points from any eventing division. Championship ribbon and \$10 gift certificate

Series Champion: Best performing horse rider combination (i.e. your 2 lowest events penalty points) from 2 of our 3 eventing shows in 2018, any division. Extra awesome ribbon and cash prize! Show dates August 15th, Sept 9th, October 14th

Brief class explanations for those new to showing:

Equitation classes are judged on rider's seat and riding skills only and can be on the flat or over fences.

Hunter classes are judged on horse's movement, submission, gaits and jumping technique.

Hunter derby is an outside hunter class over fixed obstacles and traditional obstacles with jumps other required movements

Pleasure classes are judged on harmony, obedience and overall impression of being a pleasurable ride

Jumper classes are judged on clear rounds and then time. Knocking down poles incurs a 4 pt penalty per jump. 1st refusal incurs a 3 point penalty, 2nd refusal a 6 point penalty, 3rd refusal is elimination from the class. Riders with a clear round immediately enter into a jump off (course posted) which is based on time and faults.

A horse or rider fall results in elimination from the class. A fall is defined as a shoulder of a horse or rider touching the ground.

A third refusal on an over the fence class results in elimination from the class. Rider may jump one more obedience jump and must then leave course.

Dressage tests are judged on patterns you can find online or on our facebook and webpages or by emailing us.

Class List Saturday

Eventing Division I, Intro A dressage or western intro 1 pattern (choose), x-country trail course with obstacles up to 12" which can be walked over as needed up to 12" (ends) cross rails hunter course with obedience elements (stopping, turning, backing up). Western or English Tack permitted. This class is designed to be suitable as a first introduction to 3 phase eventing for the young rider or horse, but also as a fun challenge to test obedience and agility for a seasoned trail rider/horse combination. All jumping obstacles could be walked if needed (\$80)

Eventing Division II Green as grass: Intro B dressage, x-country up to 15-18", and 18" show jumping, \$80, add warm up x country rounds for \$20.

Eventing Division II, Pre Beginner Novice: Dressage test Beginner Novice test a, x country up to 2ft, and 2ft show jumping, \$80, add warm up x country for \$20 each.

No riding/schooling on cross country course outside scheduled ride times!

READ THIS AGREEMENT CAREFULLY BEFORE SIGNING IT. YOUR SIGNATURE INDICATES YOU UNDERSTAND IT AND AGREE ON ITS TERMS. BY SIGNING THIS AGREEMENT, YOU AND YOUR CHILD ARE GIVING UP CERTAIN LEGAL RIGHTS, INCLUDING THE RIGHT TO SUE OR RECOVER DAMAGES IN CASE OF INJURY, DEATH OR PROPERTY DAMAGES, FOR ANY REASON, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO, THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE STABLE; IT'S OWNER Sarah and Robert Edwards, EMPLOYEE AND AGENTS ("THE RELEASEES").

In consideration for allowing me (or my minor child) to handle and ride a horse and on behalf of myself, my child or our personal representatives, heirs, next-of-kin, spouses and assigns, I HEREBY:

- 1. Acknowledge that a horse or mule may, without warning or any apparent cause, buck, stumble, fall, rear, bite, kick, run, make unpredictable movements, spook, jump obstacles, step on a person's feet, push or shove a person, saddles or bridles may loosen or break – all of which may cause the rider to fall or be jolted, resulting in serious injury or death.**
- 2. ACKNOWLEDGE THAT HORSEBACK RIDING IS AN INHERENTLY DANGEROUS ACTIVITY AND INVOLVES RISKS THAT MAY CAUSE SERIOUS INJURY AND IN SOME CASES DEATH,** because of the unpredictable nature and irrational behavior of horses, regardless of their training and past performance.
- 3. Voluntarily assume the risk and danger of injury or death inherent in the use of the horse, equipment and gear** provided to me by Sarah Edwards, and/or Robert Edwards and/or Red River Equestrian Center, all located at 5062 120th Ave N Felton MN hereinafter referred to as the Stable.
- 4. RELEASE, DISCHARGE AND PROMISE NOT TO SUE the Stable,** doing business under its own name or any other name and/or any of its owners, officers, employees and agents (hereinafter the "Releasees"), for any loss, liability, damages, or cost whatsoever arising out of or related to any loss, damage, or injury (including death) to my person or property.
- 5. Release the Releasees from any claim that such Releasees are or may be negligent in connection with my riding experience or ability** including but not limited to training or selecting horses, maintenance, care, fit or adjustment of saddles or bridles, instruction or riding skills or leading and supervising riders.
- 6. INDEMNIFY, AND SAVE AND HOLD HARMLESS the Stable, instructors, its employees and agents from and against any loss, liability, damage or cost** they may incur arising out of or in any way connected with either my use of the horse and any equipment of gear provided therewith or any acts or omissions of wranglers or other employees or agents.
- 7. The Undersigned expressly agrees that the foregoing release and waiver of liability, assumption of risk, and indemnity agreement is governed by the State of MINNESOTA and is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by MINNESOTA Law (RIDE AT YOUR OWN RISK),** and that in the event any portion of this Agreement is determined to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable, the validity, legality and enforceability of the balance of the Agreement shall not be affected or impaired in any way and shall continue in full legal force and effect.

8. **Acknowledge that this document is a contract** and agree that if a lawsuit is filed against the Stable or its owner, agents, employees, guides or wrangles for any injury or damage in breach of this contract, the Undersigned will pay all attorney's fees and costs incurred by the Stable in defending such an action.

9. **State that I am not now pregnant** and that I have no history of epileptic seizures, heart condition or any other medical problem that could be affected by horseback riding.

10. **IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT MY CHILD AND ALL RIDERS WEAR PROTECTIVE HELMET. IT IS MY UNDERSTANDING THAT A PROTECTIVE HELMET IS AVAILABLE AND HAS BEEN OFFERED FOR MY OWN OR MY CHILD'S SAFETY.**

11. If the person who is to enter into this Agreement is less than eighteen (18) years of age, his/her parent or guardian must read this Agreement and sign below on the behalf of the minor.

I have read this entire Release of Liability Document. I understand it is a promise not to sue and to release the stable, It's owners, employees and agents for all claims. I have made a free and deliberate choice to sign this Release and Waiver as a condition to Releasees allowing me or my child to ride or handle a horse. I have concluded that the risks involved and the release and waiver of liability is worth the pleasure of being around horses.

I acknowledge being around horses is a dangerous, potentially life-threatening activity and I voluntarily assume all risks related to being around horses at this stable. No area on the property is considered a spectator area. I acknowledge being a participant in an equine activity and assume all risks from me being here.

ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT In consideration for receiving permission for (rider name) _____ to participate in a horse show, clinic, or other event at Red River Equestrian Center LLC located at 5062 120th Ave N, Felton MN, 56536, I or I/we, the parent/parents or legal guardian/ guardians of above said person, if participant is under the age of 18 (hereinafter referred to as "RELEASORS") hereby agree to **INDEMNIFY, AND SAVE AND HOLD HARMLESS Red River Equestrian Center LLC, Sarah Edwards, Robert Edwards, instructors, its employees and agents, and owners of the property from and against any loss, liability, damage or cost** (hereinafter referred to as "RELEASEES") related to injury including death, that may be sustained by the participant, or to any property belonging to them WHETHER CAUSED BY THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES, or otherwise while participating in such activity, or while in, or upon the premises where the activity is being conducted.

Releasors are fully aware that there are inherent risks involved in the equine activity. Such risks may include, but are not limited to: 1) The tendency of an animal to behave in ways that may result in injury, harm or even death to persons on or around them. 2) The unpredictability of an animal's reaction to such things as sounds, sudden movement and unfamiliar objects, persons or other animals. 3) Certain hazards such as surface and subsurface conditions. 4) Collisions and contact with other animals or objects.

Releasors hereby elect to voluntarily participate in said activity, and to enter the above named premises and engage in such activity knowing that the activity may be hazardous to the participant and its property. **Releasors VOLUNTARILY ASSUME FULL RESPONSIBILITY FOR ANY RISKS OF LOSS, PROPERTY DAMAGE OR PERSONAL INJURY, INCLUDING DEATH, that may be sustained by the participant or any loss or damaged property owned by them, as a result of being engaged in such an activity.
